## Euribor Panel update

**Brussels, 27 May 2026, 17:45 CET** – The European Money Markets Institute (EMMI) and KBC Bank today announce the inclusion of KBC Bank in the Euribor panel. This follows the completion of the relevant assessments and onboarding procedures.

KBC Bank is expected to start contributing input data to Euribor on 1 June 2026.
